Greater Lycoming Habitat for Humanity (GLHFH) announces their Faith & Family Footprint Walk beginning at their construction site at 833 Park Avenue in Williamsport. Habitat's next build site will be on Penn Street in Montgomery which is where the 12:00 groundbreaking ceremony will be held. Habitat staff, board, and supporters from Thrivent Financial Lutherans, will walk from the Park Avenue address to Riverfront Park. From there, they will be transported by trolley (courtesy of River Valley Transit) to the new construction site in Montgomery.
